

- Clarify who is doing what activities.
- Provide an understanding of risks and risk mitigation.
- Satisfy regulatory and compliance requirements.
- Liability.
- Dealing with unforeseen circumstances.
- Control e.g. safety, security, safeguarding.
- Price.


